

NOTES: I have underlined letters in names where it is obvious that there has been a transposition of letters. Due to poor handwriting by the census taker, the published indexes are full of errors. If you are unable to find your people, start to look for other possible spellings. Sometime they are not indexed, so you will have to go through the complete county where you believe they lived. I have found families many times in this manner.

These early census returns are very difficult to read in many cases, especially the 1810 and 1820. They were done on any kind of paper and most do not have the column headings or lines down and across the pages. Therefore, be aware that there are many errors. They may be better than none at all.

CENSUS INDEX ANALYSIS

The previous two pages give the Pearson, Pierson, Person and other variations of spellings in the 1820, 1830, 1840 and 1850 Georgia Census indexes by county. The following is an analysis of the number of families in each county by the same years. This may help you to see the migration patterns of some of these families. After this listing is a map of Georgia naming the counties. Maps help you to find your families, so you should use them all of the time. Using first names in the various indexes you may also be able to trace some families.

The 1820 census was compiled on blank paper with the titles and age categories written in. There are many problems with this one in the Georgia counties I have searched because the category titles were not transferred to the following pages and the ink had faded a great deal by the time they were microfilmed. One example is that of Peter Pearson found in Wilkinson County in 1820. His name is legible but the enumeration marks are not. In the index his name was shown at "Epter" as noted. In 1830 he is still in Wilkinson Co., 1840 he had moved to Stewart and by 1850 was in Marion County. When you look at the map, you can see the southwestern migration and the increase in number of families in Stewart County are Peter's children.

Have you used these census indexes to trace your families? If not, you may be missing a very important source. When I found Jesse C. Pearson in the 1850 census in Tallapoosa County, Alabama, it stated that he had been born in Georgia. There is one Jesse Pearson in the 1840 Georgia census index. He was in Meriwether County, and this is how I found where Jesse had come from. Then searching in the records of Meriwether I found the other Pearsons in his family.

Census research work is time consuming and unless you have a repository near you where they are available, it may be difficult for you to do this work. I will attempt to do some of this, but my time is limited. If you have done some, please share it with me so that we can compile a complete record of all of the Pearsons. Sometimes the census takers only recorded the initials instead of the names. This can create problems, so be careful with them. You will need to use other records to establish the names.

Always extract all families of the same surname in a county when you are doing your census research. Then look at the map and see if there are any people of this surname in the surrounding counties. Often they lived in neighboring counties. When you get the actual locations of their lands from the land records, you will be able to locate them and see how families lived near each other. Sometimes you will be able to match up families by these locations.

Pierson Deed Initial One On County Clerk's Books

Filed In 1874 To Confirm Earlier Sale Of Land "For Love" Among Family Members

The first deed on record in the Morris County Clerk's office on page 1 of Book A is a transaction in the Pierson family. It was not the papers passing in an ordinary sale. The deed was given by Elijah Pierson, Aaron Pierson, Benjamin Pierson and David Pierson, sons of Benjamin Pierson, to Mary Spinnage, wife of Ichabod Spinnage, Catherine Pierson, Ruth Pierson and Ruth Pierson, daughter of John Pierson.

According to the recital Benjamin Pierson prior to the execution of his will in 1783 conveyed a tract of 36 acres to John Pierson, a son. The deed had been destroyed or lost accidentally and the four brothers joined in the deed of June 3, 1784 to confirm the sale of John Pierson whereon he lived and to increase the acreage to the grantees. The consideration was love. The tract conveyed, including the 36 acres, was 100 acres of land.

The Piersons who jumped from Long Island to Piersonville, discussed in this column last week, were not the first of the name to arrive in Morris County. The earlier ones had stopped on their way from New England and Southampton to settle Newark.

Family tradition is that the Morris Plains branch arrived there before 1700 but this seems hardly possible as the earliest of the deeds from the proprietors to individuals in that section are dated about 1715. Thomas, born in Newark in 1677, is said to be the first to come and acquire land. He started the saw mill on Central avenue, Morris Plains. The mill pond is still there, also the homestead of the family.

In 1799 the 120 acres of Samuel Pierson, a soldier in the Revolution, was divided by commissioners among his heirs. The land stretched for over a half mile along Central avenue from the junction with Stiles avenue, and extended along the old abandoned Dover road on the State Hospital property. Those participating in the division were Timothy, Silas, Stephen, Joanna, Mary, Isaac, Ebenezer. Old deed references show that Thomas Pierson, probably a brother of Samuel, owned about 60 acres on the opposite side of the road.

Woods.

Stephen Pierson early purchased the tract later owned by B. O. Canfield on Madison avenue and including what is now Normandie Park.

Daniel Pierson (1750-1831) a son of Benjamin purchased what is generally referred to as the James Wood homestead, including about eight acres of land, at South and Pine streets, running through to Morris street. He sold the place in 1814 and moved to Dayton, O. He built the Wood house. His daughter Clarissa is said to have owned the first piano in Morristown.

The Benjamin referred to in the first paragraph with his brother Abraham came into the Convent region early in the history of the county. They both acquired large tracts of land. An old map showing a division of Abraham's 210 acres in 1792 shows that he had one son Bethuel and eight daughters. Bethuel received the largest share, 74 acres, and his children an additional 38 acres. The property was bounded by the old road from Morristown to Madison, the Punch Bowl Hollow road and Park avenue. The shares of the girls fronted on Punch Bowl road. Fifty-seven acres lay on the opposite side of Park avenue. It will be noticed that part of the farm is now part of the Saint Elizabeth College property.

Benjamin Pierson's farm adjoined that of his brother, George T. Cobb seems to have acquired much of it in his numerous purchases. An inventory of the estate of Aaron Pierson, son of Benjamin, shows that he held notes at the time of his death aggregating about \$4,000. His home was on Park avenue. He probably did a private banking business as well as farming.

The same first names were carried through the lines. There were several Abrahams, Benjamins, Davids, Ebenezers, at least two Bethuels, Lemels in two branches, etc.

Ebenezer owned a tract in Morris Plains, bounded by Hanover avenue, Stiles avenue, Central avenue and the Jaqui Pond. Ebenezer later owned the large Luse farm in Morristown, fronting on Early and Mill streets and extending over Egbert Hill. Ebenezer later purchased the farm on the Mendham road which descended to his son James S. Pierson and is now known as Gatewood, the property of George B.

Purchaser In Hanover

Lewis Pierson, senior, a son of David Pierson, about 1840, purchased a large farm in Hanover Township at the junction of Hanover avenue and the Horse Hill road. It is still in the possession of his descendants. The descent of David Pierson is traced through Patience Pierson, a daughter of Joseph in the line of Thomas Pierson. She married a Joseph Pierson whose ancestry is not known.

Thirty years ago there were three Isaac Piersons residing in Morristown, Isaac N., Isaac R. and Isaac C. The latter came to Morristown from Sparta. His father was Joseph who likely belonged to the Thomas Pierson line but had removed from the country. The other two Isaacs belonged in the direct local lines.

There is reference to the New Weston in one deed in the Jockey Hollow group. Other deeds refer to the "Road to New Weston". This was long before there was a Western avenue and the origin of the name is shrouded in mystery. There is a Weston in Massachusetts, near Boston, and a Weston in New Hampshire. In Ohio we find a New Weston. Is it possible that the name applied to a former home of a part of the family.

The early Piersons in the country appear to have been farmers and did not dabble in iron mine or forges. The saw mill at Morris Plains may indicate some dealing in timber. The distillery and cider house at Jockey Hollow came in a real estate deal and were not main sources of income if at all. One Pierson purchased a site on the Green from the First Presbyterian Church and the settling of two families on South and Pine streets may be indications of entering general business.

Piersonville Name Now Forgotten Even By Old

Was On Mt. Freedom Road, Two Miles From
Morristown—Many Of Family Settled There

With the passing of the years many hamlets or cross roads which formerly had well known names have been forgotten. For instance there is Piersonville. Few persons, if asked today, would be able to give any information about it. Yet it was but two miles from Morristown, located on the Mt. Freedom road where it is crossed by the road from Washington Valley crossing the Mt. Freedom road at the Red Oak Filling Station and proceeding on past the State Hospital dairy barns to Route 10.

From the Combined Register of the First Presbyterian Church we learn that Isaac Pierson, son of Lemel Pierson and born in 1752, moved to New Jersey in 1788, settling a little northwest of Morristown at Piersonville. He was called "Long Island Pierson." He died in 1823. He probably was not the first Pierson to own land in that locality for a deed on record from David Godden to Lemel Pierson and born in 1755, 162 acres in Morris Township for 836 pounds six shillings. The owner on the north and west sides of this tract was stated as Benjamin Pierson. Owners on the east side were Silas Condict and John Cleve Symmes. Judge Symmes before going west owned the Wheatsheaf Farm of Mrs. Gustav Kissell.

In 1826 the 171 acres of David Pierson, extending from the Whippanny river to the cross road, were divided among his heirs. There were two shares east of the Mt. Freedom road at the cross road and a lot above the cross road as well as eight wood lots stretching toward Mt. Freedom. Those allotted land under the division were Albert, Jonathan, Benjamin, Stephen, Mary (Brown), Charles, Ira and Lewis, so there were a few of the Pierson family land owners there at that time.

But that was not all for to the east of the Mt. Freedom road was Gabriel, who owned from the river up to the David Pierson line and around it to the cross road. He also owned the third corner at the cross roads and sold a plot to Jacob Beers, two of whose daughters married two Pierson brothers of the Morris Plains branch of the family.

ing the site of the Armory. Plots were assigned to David Jr., Elias, John, Lewis and Rhoda. A distillery and cider house were somewhere in the layout. Elias parceled out his possessions to his children. The house where he lived and 51 acres, including the Armory site, went to Amzi, remembered by old residents: Ira received the outlying Armstrong farm; Elias H. a farm in Mendham Township adjoining Wick, Anderson and Guerin, and Jesse received the Stowbridge farm of 44 acres in Hanover Township. Jesse acquired land opposite this tract which his heirs sold to the county and on which is the Shongum Sanitarium and the Welfare House.

Sales In Jockey Hollow

The senior Lemel Pierson was born on Long Island in 1717 but died near Morristown in 1797. He belonged to the Henry Pierson branch of the family. Gabriel was a son of Benjamin Pierson of the Abraham Pierson branch of the family. Lemel was the ancestor of Maltby G. and Isaac N. Pierson who resided on Normandie Heights within the memory of residents.

Piersonville had at least one large Summer boarding house—that kept by George F. Bache on the cross road. In 1838 Andrew Bache purchased 80 acres of land on both sides of the Mt. Freedom road above the cross roads. There were several real estate transfers and in 1860 George F. Bache secured most of the property, Andrew Bache retaining a portion along the Lake road. Here he maintained a boarding house with pond in front while George F. carried on his business between the Lake road and the Mt. Freedom road. Both houses have long been gone. In a deed back in 1836 there is reference to the Piersonville school house.

The large boarding house conducted by Lewis W. Walton on the Mt. Freedom road was on the Morristown side of the river but located on the tract acquired by Lemel Pierson in 1784.

There was another colony of Piersons not so far away. There was a court division of lands of David Pierson in 1804. His farm was on both sides of the Jockey Hollow road at the junction of the Pickatinny road and includ-

Bethuel Pierson enters this picture and in 1834 his executors sold to Mahlon Guerin the former L. C. Gillespie estate, now Villa Walsh, part of the Jones' Woods water tract of Morristown and some other lands, 141 acres in all. Lewis and Elias Pierson had small tracts fronting on the Jockey Hollow road and excepted from this sale. Bethuel also owned on the Mendham road at the junction of the Pickatinny road.

Bethuel and David Pierson were probably brothers. The members of the Pierson clan were very numerous and the same first names were carried in all three branches, settling near Morristown. There were at least two Bethuels, several Davids, Ebenezers, Isaacs, Daniels, etc.

Another family of Piersons resided at Mt. Freedom, Job Pierson purchasing from Jabesh Trowbridge in 1802. This branch of the family was represented here by Alpheus Ebenezer Pierson who lived at Western avenue and Miller street and his brother George Pierson who owned the old Johnson house not far away.

Another Pierson who later went to the Washington Valley vicinity was Ebenezer, father of James S. and Samuel F. Pierson. The farm of James S. joined the Amzi Pierson farm in the rear and that of Samuel F. stretched well along toward a junction with the Piersonville owners.

Jesse C. PEARSON was born in February 1818, Georgia, (probably Wilkinson County, not Wilkes); married Sarah Elizabeth HAY about 1836. She was born November 1817, in Georgia, daughter of William Howell and Nancy (WOOTEN) HAY. Due to the destruction of all of the early records of Wilkinson County, we will probably never be able to document this. However, names in this family were used by most so we have been able to put most of the together. Jesse C. was the oldest son of Wenlock C. and Sarah (?) PEARSON. Wenlock's family was in Monroe County in the 1830 census and sold this land in 1832, moving to Meriwether County, where he died in January 1837. His estate was administered by his son-in-law, James Peyton HAY, also a son of William Howell and Nancy (WOOTEN) HAY. He had married Samantha PEARSON, 14 May 1835 in Meriwether Co. A family group sheet compiled by Peggy Tilley has been published in PTT, Vol. IV, No 2, 1992 shows another son of Wenlock C. and Sarah, Jesse's younger brother, Nathan. Peggy and I have compiled the other members of this family and it follows.

His son, James Madison PEARSON I, lived on "Pearson Plantation which eventually came into the possession of his son, Lafayette PEARSON. There is a PEARSON cemetery on the plantation which is now part of a timber company's land. James Madison PEARSON I and his wife are buried there. I am g-g-grandson of JMPI. I have the diary and will of William Head PEARSON.

++ + + + + + + + + + Research suggestions: Land records in Tallapoosa County will give you the land description for the Pearson Plantation. Then you will need to get a county highway map which gives the township, lot, range, and district. I have copies of a few deeds where James M. and his wife, Elizabeth A. Pearson sold land, a lot in Dadeville, dates 24 April 1847. I am not researching these families, but Jesse C. Pearson lived in this county from 1845 to about 1855; moved to Shelby County, where he lived until the late 1890's. He is not related to them, either. Editor. (1850 Census resided in Twp. 21.)

#58 PEARSON, TINDALL, HUTCHINSON. Robert PEARSON settled in New Jersey in the late 1600's. Robert Pearson II m. Elizabeth TINDALL; dau. Elizabeth born 17 Oct 1710. She m. John HUTCHINSON 24 March 1730. Who were John's parents? John was of Perth Amboy Twp. (Middleses) NJ; Elizabeth Pearson of Nottingham (Burlington) NJ. Robert Pearson II's will:


